

Minutes of Westlinton Parish Council AGM held in Blackford School on Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> August at 7pm 2020.

Apologies: Fiona Kay, Steven Nicholson, Hudson Gray and Helen Forrester.

Present: Robert Murray, David Coulthard, John Wharton and the clerk.

Declaration of Interests: RM involved in bus shelter build.

Election of Office Bearers and Councillors: Although unable to be present the councillors had expressed their wishes that RM and DC remain Chair and vice-chair. They were duly proposed and elected. SN was accepted onto the council in his absence and it was decided that Vicky Murray, who has not attended any meetings for a long time, should be replaced. Ann Hewson was suggested.

Minutes of last meeting: Read and approved.

Matters arising: JW was thanked for the milestones. The clerk has made initial enquiries about the metal work to go on them.

Accounts: At present there is £17,759-35 in the account. Much of this is grant money and £3,500 of this was for the second bus shelter. Work will start on this shortly. JW signed some cheques as these will be needed for the materials and builder for the bus shelter.

Wind Farm Grants: Some of the grants awarded by the council have not been used as a result of the Covid 19 restrictions but some of these may be able to happen when the situation eases. The clerk will meet with Ann Greig for the purchase of the bulbs to be planted through Newtown.

Planning: The clerk was asked to get back to Barbara Percival for clarification on sewerage system at Green Meadows and this council would like to be informed on the siting of it and the completion date.

Highways: Water still flowing over the road at the Y junction. Parking on the road outside Alan Tuer Ltd. Is causing obstruction. Could they be asked to have off road parking for unloading lorries. Fly Tipping is more and more a problem on the roads. Would solar powered cameras at hot spots be an answer. The clerk will contact CALC for advice.
